

## **The History of Treaty Making - Day One**

This workshop is about the history of treaties made in what is now Saskatchewan. The day begins with a jigsaw activity where teachers work in groups. A First Nation's Elder talks about her/his life experiences under the Indian Act, cultural teachings and contemporary issues. A brief look at the Treaty resource materials in the K - Grade 12 Treaty Resource Kit is followed by an activity on the Treaty Essential Learnings (TEs). A treaty teacher leader (TTL) will be present to discuss her/his duties and how a TTL can be of assistance within their school and school division. Some resources from the Treaty Kit are utilized to model how they can be used in the classroom.
